The event consists of a series of outdoor activities that patrols and Troops can participate in remotely at their home base campsite with the aim of reducing the spread of COVID-19. Like the previous virtual camporee, digital tools and a live stream will be used to tie the event together.

Your unit will join the Gold Rush Virtual Camporee from your home base on Saturday, April 24 at 9:00am. There will be a variety of competitions that will then be joined/reported in a live stream throughout the day. Some of these activities are focused on Scout skills and teamwork, and others are just for fun. Additionally, there will be a cooking competition as
