PROGRAM AREAS

These areas are used for classes, open hours, and are available to reserve for your group's needs, whether your group is a school, club, Scouting group or other group.

CLIMBING AND BOULDERING WALLS

Reservations are available Wednesdays, Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays.

Main Rock Climbing Wall

Our Main Rock climbing wall features 7 lanes for climbing, Each lane with 4 paths to the top increasing in difficulty. Great for anyone from beginners to those fine tuning their skills!



Climbing up our north tower and get a great view of camp from the top! 3 lanes, each with 3 options to get to the top.

Bouldering Cave

Our Bouldering cave allows kids to climb around and practice different rock climbing holds.

Bouldering Walls

All of our rock climbing walls can also be used for bouldering. Bouldering is moving horizontally across the rock wall without being harnessed. Great for younger kids who are just learning to use the climbing holds and anyone who wants to challenge themselves to move across the Rock Climbing wall.

MAKERSPACE

Our brand new Makerspace features a variety of tools, and projects including a Glowforge, two 3D printers, soldering equipment and more! Great for those who are just getting into making, want to try something new, or are fine-tuning their craft! Including a projector, white boards, and seats 20.









DISCOVERY ROOM

Our Discovery space is built for collaboration and exploration, it includes whiteboard table tops, projector, whiteboards and seating for 24.



KITCHEN

Our small Catering Kitchen features warming ovens, a large pantry and a commercial refrigerator great for keeping field trip lunches cold, storing food for an event, or holding a cake for your birthday party!



MAIN ACTIVITY SPACE

The Main Activity Area is our largest space. Activities in this space will change through the week an month! This large space holds up to 20 round tables and features a projector and large screen. This unique space could be perfect for a large event! 4 large nets come down to transform this space into an indoor archery range or group activity space.



MEZZANINE

The second floor mezzanine is a great place to sit and watch the action, with tables, chairs, soft seating and younger kid activities, it is a great place to hang out! Our SkyTrail® Air Adventure Course starts on the mezzanine





PRIMARY ACTIVITIES

ROCK CLIMBING AND BOULDERING

Two rock climbing walls and a bouldering cave provide many opportunities to take learning and self confidence to new heights! Reservations are available Wednesdays, Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays.

INDOOR ARCHERY

Rain or shine, the Indoor archery course allows you to keep your eye on the target! With 10 lanes there is opportunity to reserve your own lane for practice, rent the range for a group, or just come during open hours to learn how to shoot! Lane Reservations are available Tuesdays, Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays.



Step out of your comfort zone and into the sky! Get harnessed and try out the different obstacles as you suspend 9 ft in the air. With 10 different obstacles all connected there are an endless number of routes you can take. Must be at least 42" tall to go on the course with an adult and 48" or taller to go on the course alone. Open Fridays, Saturdays, and Sundays.

LASERSHOT

LaserShot is a simulator that allows participants to show off their marksmanship in target shooting challenges, Skeet shooting competition, and more! All participants will learn or review gun and range safety. Recommended for older youth or adults.

MAKERSPACE

Stop in to our Makerspace when open to learn about 3D printing and laser-cutting, complete different tinker activities, and get hands on with Maker Projects. Looking to rent time to use the machines in the Makerspace? Check out our website for more information about training requirements and rental rates.

ROBOTICS AND DRONES

Our Discovery Space has a variety of different hands on activities to explore technology and science. Come visit to check out what activity we are featuring today!




Lange Innovation Center has a variety of opportunities for volunteering and part-time employment!

WHO ARE SKIP AND ALEX LANGE?

A SCOUTING FAMILY, THROUGH AND THROUGH

Sandy Lange is an Eagle Scout and Firecrafter from 1969. His father Skip is an Eagle Scout and former Scoutmaster of Troop 510. His mother Alex was a very involved Scouting volunteer. Sandy was a part of Troop 510 and had his first overnight campout at Camp Belzer, where he later became a Firecrafter. Skip Lange was one of the first Scoutmasters to bring rock climbing into Scouting activities in the late 1960s, making it very fitting that his name lives on a building that contains three rock climbing/bouldering walls.

LONGTIME SCOUTING SUPPORTERS

Skip and Alex Lange are the namesakes for the Innovation Center, but who are they? The Lange family has a rich history in Scouting and have been longtime, generous donors to the Crossroads of America Council. The Lange family also holds the namesake for the spectacular Lange Waterfront on the banks of Lake Monroe at Ransburg Scout Reservation. Their family also sponsors the "Lange Challenge", set up by Skip Lange, a program that incentives camping and other outdoor Scouting activities by rewarding the Crossroads of America Council with significant contributions to its annual operating budget. Now, Sandy Lange, son of Skip and Alex Lange, decided to generously donate to create the Skip and Alex Lange Innovation Center in honor of his parents.

WHAT IT MEANS TO BE THE NAMESAKE OF THE INNOVATION CENTER

Sandy Lange believes it would mean a lot to his late parents to be the namesake of the Lange Innovation Center. For him, it is an honor, "to have their name on this facility where hundreds of thousands of kids are going to come through and hopefully be exposed to Scouting, expand the program, expand participation, through tons of fun activities". From rock climbing walls, indoor archery areas, and spaces for more adventure and education-based discovery, Lange knows his dad and mom would be proud to be a part of this "perfect way to introduce people to the Scouting programs".



OUR BUILDING'S HISTORY

FROM THE "BELZER FIELDHOUSE" TO THE SKIP + ALEX LANGE INNOVATION CENTER

The Camp Belzer Fieldhouse was built in 1932 and is significant for its illustration of the Boy Scouts of America's mission to positively influence the character development of young people. The building displays its role in the development of youth through its noble positioning on Camp Belzer's campus and its unaltered, original facade of earth tones, featuring Indiana limestone.

The fieldhouse was first ideated by Chief Scout Executive F. O. Belzer in the Indianapolis Council's Board of Directors meeting in July of 1929. He wanted the "recreation shelter hall" built because the camp had no place for Scout activities and programs to continue during inclement weather, as Indiana so often deals with.

The fieldhouse was completed in the summer of 1932. It originally held a campfire arena, stage and bleachers for Scout ceremonies. Archery and shooting rangers were also constructed indoors which were beneath the bleachers. An arena for track and field events was also built inside the fieldhouse. We are glad that in the 2021-2022 renovations of the fieldhouse, indoor archery was brought back to life inside the Lange Innovation Center.

In 1948, the front section of the fieldhouse was converted into workshops and storage for the camp ranger. The original footprint of the Belzer fieldhouse was changed after 1958 when the back half of the building was demolished. For many years, the fieldhouse served only as the maintenance facility for camp rangers until 2021, when a new maintenance facility was constructed and remodeling began for the Skip + Alex Lange Innovation Center.
