What's changing?


- Criminal Background Check Waiting Period: New adult volunteers must complete a criminal background check (CBC) and <u>wait for approval</u> before assuming a leadership role.
- **Simplified unit renewal:** The focus of unit renewal is now on renewing the unit's charter and ensuring all adult leaders have completed necessary training and background checks.
- Individual Memberships: Your BSA membership, whether youth or adult, lasts for 12 months from the day you register. Renewals are independent of your unit's renewal cycle.
- Individual Fee Management: Members (or families)
 now directly renew their BSA memberships and pay
 associated fees. <u>Units may choose</u> to pay and
 manage these fees on behalf of members.





Benefits

- Safety First: New adult volunteers need a completed and approved criminal background check (CBC) for youth protection. This ensures a safe Scouting experience for everyone.
- **Streamlined process:** Separating membership renewal simplifies the renewal process for both units and individual members.
- Focus on unit operations: The renewal process now focuses on ensuring the unit itself is prepared for the coming year.
- Flexibility for membership: Members have more control over their membership.



Criminal Background Check


Updated Process
 Criminal Background Check (CBC) must be received BEFORE a new adult volunteer can assume a leadership role.

Workflow Change

- Applicant and unit Key 3 are notified via email that application is pending.
- During this review process, adults are not eligible to meet with youth
- Once completed, applicant and unit Key 3 are notified when review is completed.

Major Impact

- 3-5 day delay for CBC processing and review
- Rechartering Units
- Camp Leaders
- New Units



Streamlined Renewal Process

Recharter is being replaced by:

Membership Renewal: To renew youth and adult members' 12-month registration with the BSA (regardless of when the unit renews).

Auto-Renewal

Individual membership renewal and fees are paid automatically by the individual

Manual Renewal

Individual membership renewal and fees are paid to the unit or local council office.

Unit Paid Renewals

Individual membership renewal and fees are paid by the unit

Unit Renewal - To renew unit's charter with the BSA. Renewal date is based on unit's effective date. Login at My.Scouting.org and go to Organization Manager (Unit Leader, committee chair, chartered organization representative. or designee have access) Click on "Unit Renewal "on the menu. Validate Information Make changes to Leadership if needed in Position Manager - Have leaders take YPT if needed E-Sign the Page **Pay and Submit Submit Signed Annual Unit Charter Agreement**



Reminder: National Membership Fee Change


- Effective April 1, 2024
- For all new and existing members
- Youth Members
 - New member joining fee eliminated
 - Annual registration increases by \$5
- Adult Volunteers
 - Annual registration increases by \$5




Sample Workflow




Sample Workflow









Membership Renewal

- Applies to all youth and adult members of the BSA.
- All registrations are for 12 months.
- Renew on the anniversary of the member's joining date.
- Membership renewal can be completed by either the individual / family or the unit.
 - Auto-Renewal Individual membership renewal and fees are paid automatically by the individual after providing method of payment in My.Scouting. Must opt-out to prevent future payments.
 - Manual Renewal Individual membership renewal and fees are paid to the unit or local council office. The
 unit or council receives the funds and then processes the renewal in My.Scouting.
 - Unit Paid Renewals Individual membership renewal and fees are paid for by the unit using a method of payment provided by the unit. When unit opts-in to paying renewal for all members, the individual / family will not be able to pay for their own renewal.

Auto-Renewal

Individual membership renewal and fees are paid automatically by the individual

Manual Renewal

Individual membership renewal and fees are paid to the unit or local council office.

Unit Paid Renewals

Individual membership renewal and fees are paid by the unit



Membership Renewal

Family/Self Pay

- An email notification and a renewal link will be sent 60 days before membership expires.
- The link provided in the email will direct individuals to a renewal form on My.Scouting
- If registered in multiple positions, select the primary position. Renewing the primary position will automatically renew multiple positions.
- The individual pays with a credit card and submits the renewal.
- The unit will approve the membership renewal.

Unit Pay

- In Organization Manager, the unit selects the Unit Pay option.
- Unit Key 3s are notified each month about which members are due to renew that month.
- Using the Roster tab, the unit selects which members they are renewing.
- The unit can choose not to renew a member (opt-out). The unit can also change the Scout's Life subscription settings for each person.
- The unit pays with a credit card or establishes a securely stored electronic fund transfer payment (ACH) and submits the renewal.



Next Steps for Units

- Decide: Will your unit pay renewals for all members?
 - My.Scouting > Organization
 Manager > Settings
- **Inform:** Tell your parents about the changes and how this will affect them.
- Update: Ensure that parents' correct email addresses are entered in My.Scouting or Scoutbook.
- Monitor: Look for renewal notices in your inbox starting in June (for August renewals).
